Notes

- 1) In most NOTIS systems It is possible (or will be possible in the future) to use the ESC key instead of the FUNC sequence (i.e., one key instead of three!)
- 2) A key with this inscription does not exist on all terminal types; or the key may exist, but yield a code different from the one assumed here. Table I lists key sequences that may be used to achieve the same results.
- 3) This character does not exist on all terminal types. Table II lists characters that may be used instead.
- 4) This key has a different inscription on new NOTIS terminals:

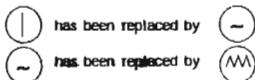
